*“Repent, Rejoice, & Reap a Harvest in 2024!”*



### Invitation

Senior Pastor Andrew D. Singleton Jr. and the Prayer Connection Ministry invites the entire Victory Apostolic Church family to participate in a **Six Day Consecration Fast** as we repent, rejoice, and reap a harvest in 2024.

Beginning **Sunday, January 7 thru Friday, January 12, 2024**, we ask you to humble yourself in the presence of our Heavenly Father to meditate, pray, and fast. Please be a part of the great move of God at Victory Apostolic Church, being on one accord with the Father as we witness a caravan of souls drawn out of darkness into God's marvelous light. Let's rejoice for the greater harvest.

Please mark your calendar and join us in the church's sanctuary, **Friday, January 12th@ 7:00 p.m.** for our Revival Service. We will come together to close out this Six Day Consecration Fast with prayer, worship, the Word, and the anointing of God's people.

#### SELECT FROM THREE TYPES OF FASTING FOR 6 DAYS

**Option 1: FULL FAST** - No food, No liquids *except* what is necessary for taking medication from 6 AM to 6 PM

**Option 2: PARTIAL FAST** - A partial fast is from 6:00am to 12:00pm or from sun up to sundown. No food and light liquids.

**Option 3: THE DANIEL FAST** - Eat no meat, no sweets and no bread. Drink water and juice. Eat fruits and vegetables the ENTIRE six days

We also believe It is important that restitution, not just taking from God, but giving back to Him those things that will assist us to become better and more Christ like in the days ahead of us.

God's divine power has given us everything we need to live an abundant life, full of his goodness and his mercy.

Please prayerfully take time to spiritually prepare your hearts and your minds as we enter into this Six Day Holy Consecration before the Lord.

1	Who Are You?	<b>1 John 3: 1</b> Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: and that is what we are! Therefore, the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.	Man was made in the image and likeness of GOD. I am a son of GOD, I am the salt of the earth. I find rest in this description of my identity.  Revival begins with repentance. This refers to the spiritual renewal, restoration, and rejuvenation that come from being in the presence of God. It signifies the experience of His grace, mercy, and transformative power in your life. Times of refreshing brings deep joy, peace, and a renewed sense of purpose as you walk in fellowship with God. 2	Repent!	<b>Acts 3:19</b> Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.		Heavenly Father, create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit within me. Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer. Let my heart be washed by the water of the Word and may the purifying light of the Holy Spirit cleanse my thoughts. Revive me again. In Jesus Name, Amen.
3	Whose Are You?	<b>1 Peter 2:9</b> But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellences of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.	The Lord God Almighty has chosen me to pray His will into the earth, to pray for my nation, family and community. The Lord has chosen me to declare the power of salvation to my family, friends and neighbors. In the name of Jesus Christ our Savior and Lord.	Our Father in Heaven: Thank you for creating the space and purpose to commune with you. Thank you for calling me to the throne of grace to be intimate with you. In Jesus Name
4	Rejoice!	<b>Philippians 4:4</b> Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!	Paul rejoiced in the Lord while he was in prison. As Paul did, so should you. Whatever situation you find yourself in, it should be with an attitude that would glorify God. Look at your trial with the right perspective. Find joy in it! Rejoice!
