Senior Pastor Andrew D. Singleton, Jr. invites the entire Victory Apostolic Church family and friends to join a 31-Day Consecration Fast as we prayerfully embrace “This Is the Year of Celebrations.” This year, Victory celebrates Pastor Singleton’s 75th birthday, the burning of our church mortgage, and Victory’s 30th anniversary.

From **Thursday, January 1–Saturday, January 31, 2026**, set aside intentional time for Scripture reading, meditation, prayer, and fasting. Our 31-Day Consecration Guide is purposefully crafted to engage your heart, renew your body, and align your spirit with God’s plans for Victory and for your life.

Throughout January, Bible class lessons will highlight the celebration of creation and the families of Genesis, showing how these themes speak directly to us today. Each daily focus ties into our annual theme: “The Year of Celebrations.”

Please also join us on **Sunday, January 18, 2026, at 10:30 a.m. for a Special Consecration Worship Service**—a time of prayer, worship, the Word, and anointing with oil as we near the completion of our 31-day journey.

The fast begins with two weeks on the Celebration of Creation, followed by two weeks focused on Celebrating the Families of Genesis.

SELECT ONE OF THE FASTING OPTIONS AND FOLLOW THE ENTIRE 31 DAYS

Option 1: DANIEL FAST

Eat no meat, no sweets and no bread. Eat only fruits and vegetables and drink water and 100% fruit or vegetable juice for the entire 31 days

Option 2: COMPLETE FAST

No food, no liquids except those necessary for medication, from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily

Option 3: PARTIAL FAST

No food, no liquids except those necessary for medication, from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. daily

1	The Beginning of All Things Genesis 1:1	Everything begins with God. Creation reminds us that God initiates, designs, and sustains all things. He also desires to do a creative work in you this month—reshaping, renewing, and realigning your life to His will.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and how it is at work in our lives. Thank You for awakening new beginnings, new vision, and fresh purpose in me this month. In Jesus' name, Amen.
2	God Speaks Light Genesis 1:3–4	God's first spoken word brought light into darkness. As you consecrate yourself, allow God's light to illuminate every hidden place in your life.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for bringing Your light into my life. Thank You for shining clarity, understanding, and guidance into every area that needs Your illumination. In Jesus' name, Amen.
3	The Sky Above Genesis 1:6–7	God establishes order and separation for a purpose. He brings harmony and structure to creation and to our lives.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for bringing divine order, peace, and structure into my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.
4	Land, Sea & Vegetation Genesis 1:9–11	God provides sustenance and life through the earth. Every seed and tree is part of His plan.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation, providing abundance, growth, and provision in my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.
5	Sun, Moon & Stars Genesis 1:14	God created time and seasons. Everything operates in divine rhythm.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for establishing seasons, cycles, and order in my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.
6	Sea Creatures & Birds Genesis 1:20–21	God fills the waters and sky with life, demonstrating His creativity and generosity.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for filling my life with purpose, beauty, and divine creativity. In Jesus' name, Amen.
7	Animals & Humankind Genesis 1:24–27	Humanity is made in God's image. He delights in us and gives us stewardship over the earth.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for creating me in Your image, giving me purpose and responsibility in Your kingdom. Lord, I look forward to participating in "This Year of Celebrations." In Jesus' name, Amen.
8	Be Fruitful Genesis 1:28	God blesses us to multiply, succeed, and flourish.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for blessing me with the ability to bear fruit spiritually, physically, and mentally. In Jesus' name, Amen.

9	Very Good Genesis 1:31	God declares His work very good, so He delights in our lives when they are aligned with Him.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for completing Your work in my life, and in the 30 years of blessings upon my church, declaring it good and purposeful. In Jesus' name, Amen.
10	The Seventh Day Rest Genesis 2:2–3	Rest is holy. God instructs us to pause and reflect, restoring our body, mind, and soul.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for teaching me the importance of rest and renewal in You. Lord, thank you for even making a way for my Pastor to rest as he approaches his 75th birthday. In Jesus' name, Amen.
11	Formed by God's Hands Genesis 2:7	You are not accidental. God intricately formed you with purpose and intention.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for carefully crafting me to fulfill Your plans and destiny. In Jesus' name, Amen.
12	Planted in Purpose Genesis 2:8	God places us where we are meant to thrive. He gives life direction and environment.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for placing me where I can grow, prosper, and serve Your kingdom. In Jesus' name, Amen.
13	The Tree of Life Genesis 2:9	God gives choice and access to life and nourishment.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for giving me access to Your wisdom, life, and abundance. In Jesus' name, Amen.
14	It Is Not Good to Be Alone Genesis 2:18	God created companionship and community to reflect His love.	Lord, thank You for the celebration of Creation and for blessing me with relationships that encourage, strengthen, and support my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.
15	The Fall and the Promise Genesis 3:6	The first family experienced the consequences of disobedience, yet God's promise of redemption began through them. Their story reminds us that God works through families, even broken ones, to bring hope.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Help me learn from their choices, obedience, and redemption so my family may grow in faith and purpose. In Jesus' name, Amen.
16	Covered by Grace Genesis 3:21	Even after their failure, God covered Adam and Eve with garments of grace. God still restores families who fall short, wrapping them in His mercy.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis and for covering my life and family with Your restoring grace. Strengthen us when we fail. In Jesus' name, Amen.

17	Abram's Call Genesis 12:1	Abram's obedience marked the beginning of a family journey shaped by God. Families thrive when they courageously follow God's leading, even into the unknown.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Teach my family and me to follow You boldly and trust Your direction. In Jesus' name, Amen.
18	Blessed to Be a Blessing Genesis 12:2–3	God blessed Abram so his family would bless the world. God's favor flows to families that share His goodness with others.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Show me how to bless others as You have blessed my family. In Jesus' name, Amen.
19	Promise of the Land Genesis 12:7	God's promises to Abram reached far beyond one generation. God still builds generational blessings through families who trust Him.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Help me trust Your promises today and for future generations. In Jesus' name, Amen.
20	Building Altars Genesis 12:8	Abram built altars as reminders of worship and covenant. Families grow stronger when they intentionally center their lives on God's presence.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Help my family honor You through worship, obedience, and devotion. In Jesus' name, Amen.
21	Abram & Lot Separate Genesis 13:8–9	Seeking peace, Abram allowed Lot to choose first. Sometimes God leads families through difficult decisions or separations that bring clarity and growth.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Give me discernment to make decisions that cultivate peace and maturity in my relationships. In Jesus' name, Amen.
22	Lift Up Your Eyes Genesis 13:14–15	After Lot departed, God expanded Abram's vision. Families who trust God experience renewed perspective, purpose, and promise.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Expand my vision to see Your purpose and promises for my life and family. In Jesus' name, Amen.
23	Isaac Promised Genesis 21:1–2	God fulfilled His long-awaited promise to Abraham and Sarah. Families can stand on the truth that God's timing is perfect, and His promises are sure.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Teach me to trust Your timing as You bring Your promises to pass in my life and family. In Jesus' name, Amen.
24	The Covenant Continues Genesis 21:12	God's covenant moved forward through Isaac, revealing that He sovereignly guides the destiny of families.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Guide my family and me to walk faithfully in the plans You have ordained. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Thank You for caring for every member of my family and hearing our cries. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
26	The Lord Tests Abraham Genesis 22:2	Abraham’s test revealed deep trust and obedience. Families grow in strength when they choose faith even in painful or challenging seasons.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Help me trust You in every test, knowing You are strengthening my life and family. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
27	Walk in Faith Together Genesis 22:8	Abraham and Isaac walked together toward the unknown, united in trust. Their journey shows that families are strongest when they choose to walk in faith together, supporting, encouraging, and believing in God even when it’s difficult.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Teach my family to walk together in faith, trusting You even when the path is uncertain or complicated. Strengthen our unity and deepen our confidence in You. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
28	Obedience Requires Sacrifice Genesis 22:13	Abraham’s willingness to offer what was most precious demonstrates that obedience often requires sacrifice. Every family must decide what they are willing to set aside: comfort, pride, time, habits, or desires, to honor God fully.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Show my family what we need to surrender to You in obedience, and give us the courage to trust Your perfect will. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
29	Jehovah-Jireh Genesis 22:14	Abraham named the place “The Lord Will Provide,” affirming God’s unwavering faithfulness. Families today can trust Him as their Provider in every circumstance.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Reveal Yourself to my family as our faithful Provider. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
30	Confirmed Covenant Genesis 13:14–15	God reaffirmed His covenant with Abraham, promising blessing and multiplication. God continues to establish generational blessings through obedient families.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Confirm Your covenant promises in my life and family. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
31	Nations Blessed Genesis 22:18	Through Abraham’s obedience, all nations and families would one day experience God’s blessing. God still works through families who surrender to Him.	Lord, thank You for celebrating the families of Genesis. Use my family to bring Your blessing to others and reflect Your heart to the world. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
